LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF SCHOOL KITS

LWML is asking for your help in collecting items for the school kits. We need supplies for 500 school bags! A Lutheran World Relief (LWR) school kit may provide the only supplies for children returning to school after the disruption of war. School kits help parents continue their children's education, even while living in a refugee camp, for example. A school kit may also be used in adult literacy classes. If you would prefer to give a donation rather than shop for supplies OR if you would like to contribute to the cost of postage (which is @ \$300.00), please **make out check to Grace Lutheran LWML** with a notation for school supplies or postage.

Below are the items needed for the school kits. There will be a box in the narthex to collect the supplies. If you have any questions, contact Jean Harsch.

<u>Items needed for each school kit:</u>	<u>Needed</u>
* Padded or spiral notebooks of ruled paper (approximately 8½" x 11" totaling 150-200 sheets) – please NO loose-leaf paper	1200
* Blunt Scissors	100
* 30-centimeter Ruler (centimeters on one side / inches on the other)	268
* Pencil sharpener	236
* New, unsharpened #2 Pencils with erasers	1300
* Eraser approximately 2-1/2" long	0
* Sheets of construction paper in assorted colors	0
* Box of 16 or 24 Crayons	375

NOTE: We no longer need Erasers or Construction paper!
